## *Dr. Britni Michelle Johnson*

A native of Chester, PA, Rev. Dr. Britni Michelle Johnson now makes her home in a quiet suburban town in Anne Arundel County, MD. She is the daughter of Anita and Inocencio Amaro, Sr., who directed her Christian upbringing. Her gifts for ministry were first recognized in the United Methodist Church when she began serving as a layperson under the leadership of Reverend Herbert Coe, Sr. at St. Daniel's United Methodist Church, in Chester, PA. In 2009, she relocated to Washington, DC where Reverend Khalfani B. Drummer acknowledged her call to ministry. She was licensed to preach in October 2013 and later ordained to the Gospel Ministry in September 2018 at the Gethsemane Baptist Church, in Washington, DC. Currently, Dr. Johnson ministers at Victory Grace Center under Dr. Jasmin "Jazz" Sculark where she oversees their discipleship ministries. In September 2019, she established the Being & Becoming Spiritual Retreat Center, an online sacred space where she provides growth workshops, social and biblical studies, and custom conferences to reach the real and relevant needs of people.

In May 2008, Dr. Johnson graduated from Towson University with a Bachelor of Science degree and was recognized as a member of the National Political Science Honor Society. Passionate about her ministry preparation, she attended the John Leland Center for Theological Studies where she earned a Master of Christian Leadership in June 2018. In June 2019, Villanova University awarded her a Certificate in Church Management. On March 6, 2023, she successfully defended her doctoral thesis on Church Leadership in the Digital Age: Cultivating Community and Spiritual Growth Online and the degree of Doctor of Educational Ministry was conferred upon her by the Virginia Theological Seminary in May 2023.

### **Course Instructor, *Seven Deadly Sins*, 2021**

Young Adult Ministry, Victory Grace Center

Instructed a small group study on the seven deadly sins and why these major moral vices are deemed most perilous to humanity. Explored how the seven heavenly virtues help to overcome these unethical behaviors.

### **Strategy Discussion Leader, *Seeking Justice - Finding Faith*, 2020**

Being & Becoming Spiritual Retreat Center

Organized and led an online forum discussing the social and biblical response to the grand jury's unjust decision not to charge any officers with the murder of Breonna Taylor. Aimed to develop tools and strategies to continue to seek justice and secure a just future for the generations of black women and black men to come.

### **Facilitator, *Eyes to the Hills*, 2020**

Being & Becoming Spiritual Retreat Center

Organized and facilitated a virtual discussion on the prophetic Message to the Black church amid the pandemic and protests, as well as its primacy in today's social justice movement. Discussed and examined the challenges to pastoring in a pandemic, maintaining personal wellness, and understanding one's ministry call.

### **Facilitator, *Broken Trust*, 2020**

Being & Becoming Spiritual Retreat Center

Organized and facilitated an online discussion in response to the community's loss of trust in law enforcement. Discussed the current brokenness in the community, clergy's role in picking up the pieces, and the origins of lost trust in law enforcement.

### **Presenter, *Appreciative Leadership and the Church*, 2018**

American Academy of Religion, Mid-Atlantic Region

Presented an academic paper analyzing the functionality of Church members operating in their spiritual gifts and carrying out works of service in unity and harmony when the use of Appreciative Leadership is applied.

Led a three-day course designed to help individuals under the age of 30 to understand where they fit in the ministry of their Church by discerning and identifying their spiritual gifts and developing plans to incorporate those gifts into existing or new ministries.

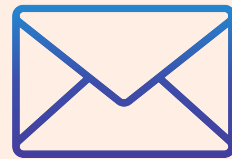
